Eligibility Requirements

- ❖ Candidates must be a family member of a GCGMS member in good standing.
- ❖ Candidates must be pursuing a bachelor's degree in engineering, science, math, accounting, marketing, business administration, supply chain management, or information systems and open to a career in the oil and/or gas industry.
- ❖ Candidates must provide academic information requested under Submission Checklist below.
- ❖ Candidates must be:
 - Accepted to or attending a 4-year institution of higher learning
 - GPA of 2.75 or higher
 - Citizen of United States of America
 - In good academic and disciplinary standing

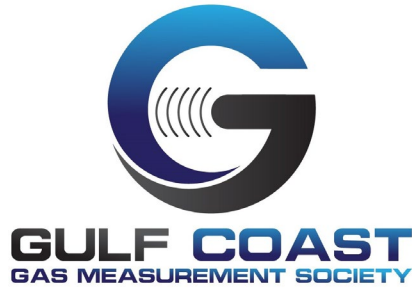
Implementation Guidelines

- ❖ Scholarship winners will be chosen on a competitive basis, based on academic achievement and the student's personal narrative.
- ❖ Scholarship winners will be chosen without regard to family financial circumstances or social status.
- ❖ The Scholarship Selection Committee is composed of the Board of Directors of the GCGMS for the effective fiscal year.
- ❖ The Scholarship Selection Committee will select recipients. If a candidate is a relative of a member of the Scholarship Selection Committee, then that Scholarship Selection Committee member will relinquish his or her voting rights for that candidate.
- ❖ Scholarships will be awarded around the traditional start of the school year (i.e. September)
- ❖ The scholarship program may be suspended or terminated at any time by the decision of the Board of Directors.
- ❖ Proof of enrollment is required (choose one from the options below)
 - 1) Copy of invoice from the college
 - 2) Official proof of enrollment form from the college.
 - 3) Proof of enrollment from online verification service such as National Student Clearinghouse.
